Representatives of companies and organizations involved in trade between Netherlands and Hong Kong

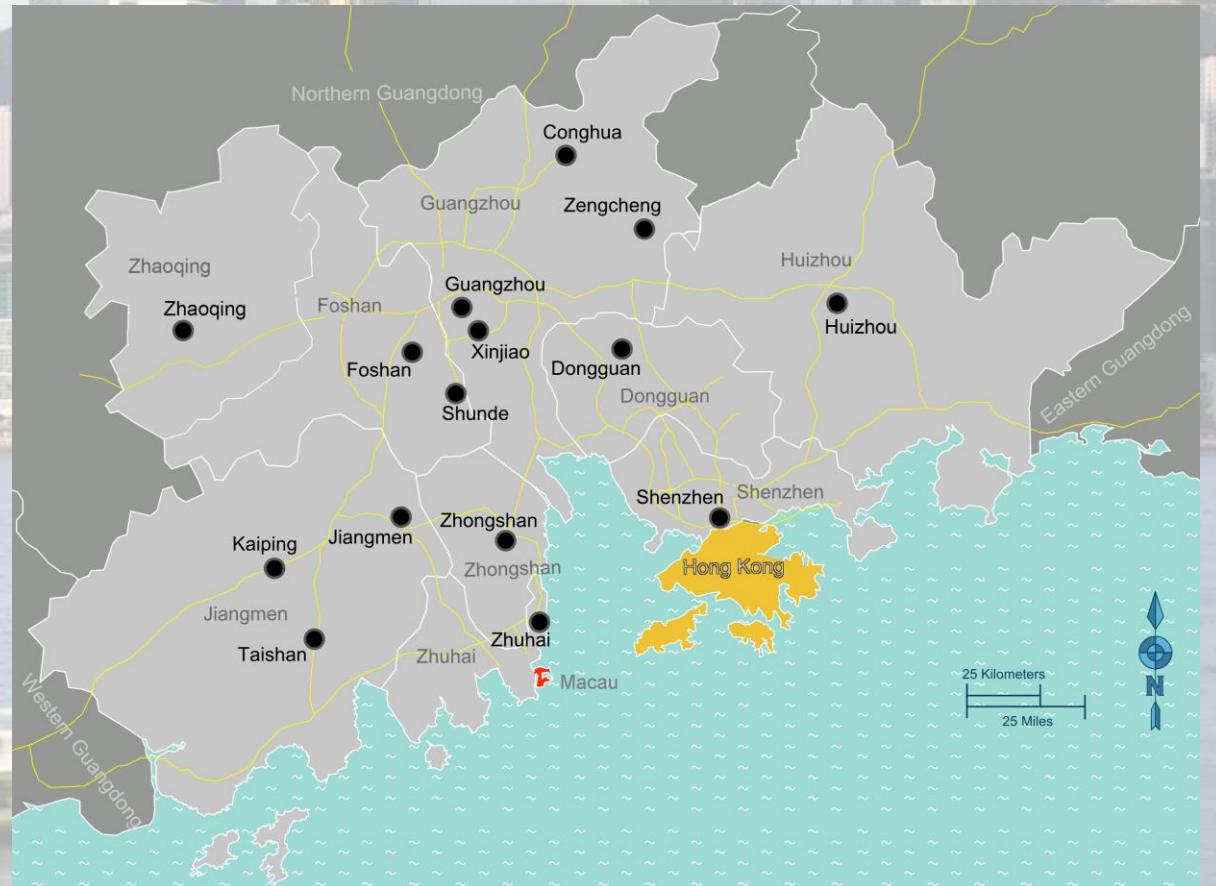
Hong Kong Advantages
